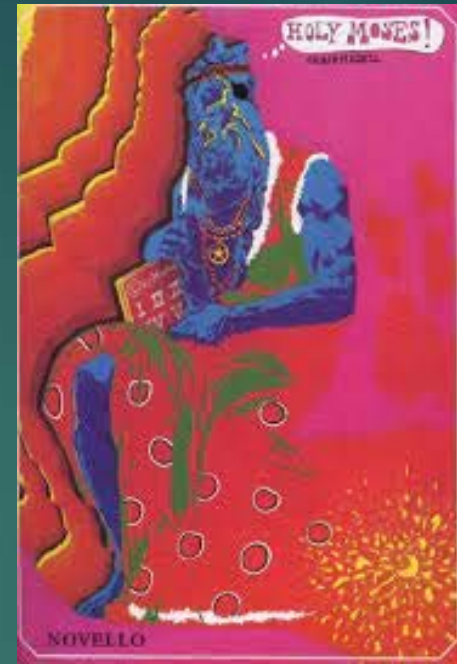




Some of the music is taught using the interactive Charanga music tool. We listen to, appraise and learn to sing a song over a half term. We supplement this with a new song to listen to each week. This might be a different song by the same performer, a song in the same genre as this or the same song performed by someone else. We use this as a basis to learn about beating time, creating rhythms, exploring pitch and dynamics and we use it as a spring board to improvise and compose.



We also aim to create links to other subjects and topics, particularly history and literacy. Throughout these specifically created units, the children can suggest music which they feel is relevant or which they would like to explore further.



We like to think of Heighington as a singing school and we take great pride in our opportunities to perform. Our Christmas Carol services take pride of place in the school calendar. We also have a choir which take every opportunity to perform both at school and within the local community.
